Summer Withdrawal

If your child will not be attending during the summer, please fill out the "change of contract" form available on the shelf in the lobby. A \$75.00 per month, per child fee will be charged to hold their spot. If spots are not held, we will fill those vacancies from our wait list. If a contract change is requested, it must be maintained for an eight-week minimum.

Covid-19 Guideline Changes

Per DHS guidelines and IA Dept. of Health guidelines, masks are welcomed, but no longer required. Regular daily practices such as family style dining, and soft animals in centers will resume. We no longer require temperature checks at arrival. Covid-19 will be added and treated in the same manner as other communicable diseases. The guideline for a positive case of COVID-19 is exclusion for 10 days after symptoms start and 24 hours without fever and improved symptoms OR 10 days after positive test without symptoms.

Daily cleaning practices will continue to maintain a clean and safe environment for all children and staff. If your child is ill, they are not allowed to attend daycare. If a child has a fever, is lethargic, vomiting, or has diarrhea, they will be sent home. Exclusion protocol will be following according to symptoms.
